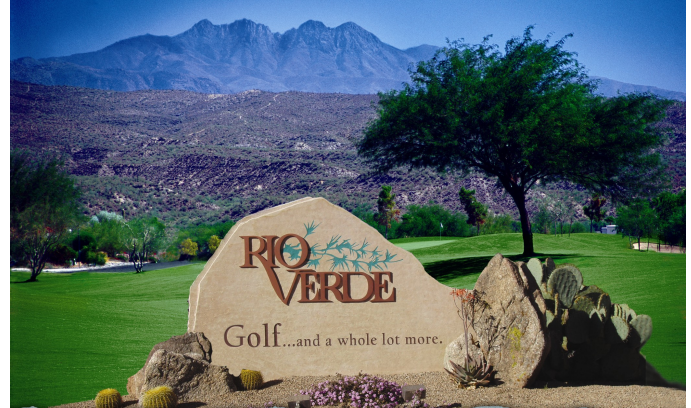

Rio Verde, AZ History

The area surrounding the Rio Verde community, northeast of Scottsdale, was settled by small farmers in the 1880s, who grew hay and alfalfa to provide for the nearby Fort McDowell US Army camp (**1865–1890**) (now the Fort McDowell Yavapai Nation).
